The students are to dress in keeping with the theme of the day or are to wear their school uniform. The following are general guidelines:

- Sleeveless tops are allowed but spaghetti straps are not
- Appropriate length shorts (as stated in our handbook, "...shorts may not extend below the top of the kneecap or be shorter than four (4) inches above the kneecap")
- Jeans will be permitted as part of dress up
- Appropriate footwear (as stated in our handbook, "Athletic shoes with socks are highly recommended, rubber "slippers" and the like may not be worn due to safety considerations")

If you have any questions, please ask Dr. Gaudi or Mr. Markillie beforehand. Also, if a student's attire is deemed inappropriate, he/she will be asked to change into the school uniform. Therefore, if in doubt, please have your child bring a uniform to school.
